FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Fellow Disciples at Shepherd of the Hills,

As this addition of the Scroll comes to you, we are about to celebrate once again The Resurrection of The Lord. I'm amused by the predictions of the possibility of a White Easter. Weather forecasters are saying that there might be snow. True enough, it could happen, but why not have an Easter Egg Hunt in the snow? It calls to mind the Spring day when I was playing in the street with my friends, and we watched it snow in Central Illinois. It was the Ist of May, and we were amazed and thrilled to see the snow one more time.
