FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Sisters and Brothers at Shepherd of the Hills,

Tomorrow, November 1st is All Saints day. For hundreds of years the Church celebrated All Saints day. This is day on which the saints who went before us, the saints that we are, and the saints yet to be born are together in a mystical union with each other to praise God for the gift of Baptism which joins us in Everlasting life, free from death and the devil with a view toward the arrival of the New Heaven and New Earth in which we will share the heavenly banquet of which the Lord's Supper is a foretaste of what is to come.

Here at SOTH, November the 1st will mark the 60th Anniversary of this household of faith which is surrounded by the beauty of the hills of McHenry. Many saints have passed through the precincts of the building built by all the Disciples of Jesus who made the choice to be a part of the warmth and service of an ELCA Lutheran congregation. Following the day of All Saints, there will be an opportunity to recall the saints who have passed into the presence of the of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. During the Liturgy at 8:30am and 10:00am the names of each of the saints who have passed away since All Saints Day 2023, will have their names read, a bell will be tolled, and a lighted candle will be placed at the front of the Chancel. Then, during the singing of the Hymn of the Day, worshipers who have lost a friend, family member or someone else significant to them between All Saints Day last year and All Saints Day this year, will be invited to go to the Narthex, pick up a lighted Tea Candle and bring it forward and place among the other candles in honor of another saint.

Another feature of the 10:00am worship will be the welcoming of a disciple of Jesus who has decided to be part of the Shepherd's Flock here.

Following the 2nd liturgy Sunday, all members are invited to an impromptu potluck to mark the 60th Anniversary of Shepherd of the Hills, to welcome the disciple who will make profession of faith and commitment to dwell with the brothers and sisters here and serve alongside fellow-members for the Glory of the Father in Heaven. Please make every effort to be a part of this multi-faceted party marking the continuing life of SOTH. Anticipate with me, a beautiful past, current day and possibility of continued fellowship and service with and for the Shepherd for whom this congregation is named.
