FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Fellow Disciples at Shepherd of the Hills,

Messages from the Easter season and our Resurrection Life



Sunday, April 21 brought us the story of the Good Shepherd. In that story we heard that the Shepherd would find us and bring us back to the safety of His Sheep Fold.

Because the Shepherd finds us it follows that we belong to the Shepherd and by Him we are included in His flock. Belonging to

the flock means that we not only belong to the Shepherd, but that we also belong to each other. As people who belong to one another, Christ our Brother calls us to use our Time Talents and Treasure to be the body of Christ—His presence—in world. That is, Jesus names us shepherds with and for Our Father in Heaven. As such, we are to bring his love and hope to others. Translated into our daily life we are disciples of Jesus learning from Him how to let the wellbeing of our sisters and brothers have a major influence on our thoughts and actions. Likewise, our watching, listening, and actions must be born of a willingness to insure that as a community of service empowered by the Holy Spirit breathing ever-flowing energy and strength into our discipleship.

A second message from Easter is well described as Resurrection Life presented in the form of the Vine and the Branches. In the Gospel of St. John, the writer paints a portrait of a vine, in the Master's vineyard, ladened with branches heavy with fruit. We disciples are like the branches of the vine. We are to bear fruit that will extend God's Kingdom. That will happen as long as we remain attached to the Vine, which is our Lord, Jesus. Our attachment will remain strong as we continue to gather for regular Praise and worship of the Lord.

May you know the life-filled Blessings of our Lord as we travel toward Pentecost and the season after Pentecost.


