### FROM THE PASTOR



The Shepherd's Horn is being heard beyond the interior of the Sanctuary. Each Sunday, SOTH broadcasts a live-stream of congregational worship. The high point of Lutheran Liturgy is the celebration of the Lord's Supper. The Eucharist is a celebratory meal that gives us a foretaste of the feast to come.

SOTH's Audio Visual operators do a great job of bringing into the worship setting the disciples and friends of Shepherd of the Hills participating at home or on the go.

Historically, the first Sunday of October has been called World Communion Sunday. In our ELCA we sporadically celebrate this Commemoration. This year I would like to offer this Occasion as a meaningful way for Shepherd of the Hills to gather into the Liturgy both the disciples in the Sanctuary and those who worship via Live-Stream. To that end, there will be individually sealed Communion elements consecrated along with the bread and wine served in the sanctuary this coming Sunday, September 24, 2023.

These consecrated elements may be picked up at the church during the week before the "World Communion Sunday" Liturgy so that all worshippers can receive the Body and Blood of Christ during the weekly worship. You or someone on your behalf may stop by during office hours Monday through Friday (Sept. 25-29) and pick up enough bread and wine containers for use during worship October 1st, 2023.

The Office is open Monday through Thursday between 9:00am and 5:00pm and Friday between 9:00am and 12:00pm.

A staff member will gladly assist you in receiving the Elements for the October 1st Liturgy.

I trust that all who receive the Consecrated bread and wine will experience the Real Presence of the Lord Jesus and sense the fellowship with the disciples gathered in the Sanctuary October 1, 2023.

Shepherd of the Hills is very blessed to provide worship and have the opportunity to share it weekly. All are welcome.


