

from the data for question #5.


- To represent our church in the best possible light, we need to improve the at home viewing experience for our members by making them feel more a part of the service through changes in the way our camera captures the service. Panning the altar, moving with the pastor and liturgist, capturing the choir, pianist, and the musicians as well as the members moving through the communion line would greatly enhance the at home viewing experience.
- If music was shown on the screens as well as the words to the songs, the participation and enjoyment of the music would be greatly enhanced.
- Making sure that the sound was always on and at appropriate volume for whomever is speaking or singing or playing instruments is critical to the flow of the service when accessing remotely. Additionally, it is very important that the screen being displayed is timely, always matching what people are hearing to keep the focus on the message.


#### Q6 As we look toward finding a new pastor for SOTH, do you consider yourself
